7 Video Cameras in the Classroom

1. Purpose

The Use of Video Cameras in any classroom setting is for the exclusive purpose of assisting the District / Educators in accomplishing remote learning as defined by the New Mexico Public Education Department (PED).

2. Allowable use

Video cameras shall only be used in the classroom during a period in which remote or hybrid learning is mandated by the NMPED.

- a. Cameras shall be provided by the District. Educators shall be properly trained on their use. The teacher shall have exclusive control and operation of the camera.
- b. The District shall not have the ability to monitor the camera feed without the Educator's knowledge.
- c. No recording shall be made of the camera feed.
- d. The camera may only be operated during formal classroom instruction.
- e. No Educator shall be disciplined for any failure to operate the camera properly. No video recording may be used for purposes of discipline in any way.
- f. No Educator shall be evaluated based upon any aspect of the use or operation of the camera, including the ability to educate by camera or remotely.
